

Haitian Literature in the Wake: A Conversation with Makenzy Orcel February 16, 2021 at 11am CST via Zoom

Born in Port-au-Prince in 1983, Makenzy Orcel is the author of four highly acclaimed novels and numerous collections of poetry published in Haiti, Canada, and France. The Immortals is his first novel, originally published in Montreal, Canada (Mémoire d'encrier, 2010) and later in France (Éditions Zulma, 2012). Orcel's latest novels are Maître minuit (Éditions Zulma, 2018) and Une boîte de nuit à Calcutta (Robert Laffont, 2019) which he co-authored with the French novelist Nicolas Idier. His poetry collection Pûr sang (La Contre Allée) and his novel L'Empereur (Payot -Rivages) are forthcoming in March 2021.
